Competitions

Afternoon competitions will be only on Friday, 1. 10. Registration for the competitions will be possible only on the day and place of the exhibition. Check-in will take place within 12 hours.

Best Breeding Group
Best Couple
Best Head - dog
Best Head - bitch
Best Ridge
Best Movement - dog
Best Movement - bitch
Best Stud Dog/progeny

Only dogs that have been judged at the show may enter these competitions.

Classes

Dogs are classified according to the ČMKU show regulations. Classes are stated in the application. Dogs must reach the required age for the class entry at least on the day of the show.

Baby class - from 4 to 6 months
Puppy class - from 6 to 9 months
Junior class - from 9 to 18 months
Intermediate - from 15 to 24 months
Open class - from 15 months
Working class - from 15 months (with working certificate)
Winner class - from 15 months
Honour class - from 15 months
Veteran class - from 8 years

The Honorary class is available for dogs or bitches that have been awarded at least one of the titles Interchampion, Champion, Club winner, Specialty winner or National winner titles. Dogs/ bitches can be presented in this class without any claims of CAC. Dogs / bitches of this class are not entered for the BOB competition.

The working class is only available for dogs and bitches with working certificate by ČMKJ. This class is available from 15 months according to the show regulations by ČMKU.

Winner class is only available for dogs and bitches that have been awarded at least one of the titles Interchampion, Champion, Club winner, Specialty winner or National winner titles. Above mentioned titles had to be awarded in adult classes.

Awarding of the titles cannot be claimed.

Club competitions

Minibaby class - to 4 months, males and females separately.

Titles

In each class the placement of the first four dogs are awarded.

CAJC, CAC, res. CAC

Best Minibaby – this title can be awarded to the winner of competition between dog and bitch that have been awarded the mark Very Promising 1 in the Minibaby class

Best Baby – this title can be awarded to the winner of competition between dog and bitch that have been awarded the mark Very Promising 1 in the Baby class

Best Puppy – this title can be awarded to the winner of competition between dog and bitch that have been awarded the mark Very Promising 1 in the Puppy class

Specialty Show Junior Winner (1. 10. 2021) – this title can be awarded to the winner of competition between dog and bitch that have been awarded the mark Excellent 1 and the title CAJC in junior class.

Specialty Show Veteran Winner (1. 10. 2021) - this title can be awarded to the winner of competition between dog and bitch that have been awarded the mark Excellent 1 in the veteran class

Best of the Speciality Show Dog, Bitch (1. 10. 2021) - this title is awarded in the competition between the winners of intermediate, open, working a winners classes that have been awarded the mark Excellent 1 and the title CAC

Best adult Dog, Bitch (2. 10. 2021) – this title is awarded in the competition between the winners of intermediate, open, working a winners classes that have been awarded the mark Excellent 1 and the title CAC

Best Opposite Sex, BOS – this title is awarded to the dog or bitch chosen from junior winners dog/bitch, veteran winners dog/bitch, or Club Winners dog/bitch (Specialty Winner dog, bitch) and must be of the opposite sex to which the title BOB has been awarded to.

Best of Breed, BOB – this title is awarded to the dog or bitch chosen in the competition of Best Junior, Club winner dog and bitch (Specialty Winner dog, bitch) and Best Veteran.

Awarding of the titles cannot be claimed - the judges have the right not to award any of the titles.

Veterinary provisions

The dog needs to be in good clinical health

The dog is not required to show official proof of clinical health.

All the dogs are required to have pet passport, which includes the official proof of vaccinations against rabies which is valid 21 days to 1 year before the show is held and that the dog is resistant to distemper, parvovirus and leptospirosis.

The dogs coming from non EU and third countries are obliged to have pet passport and have to meet the Regulation (EC) No 998/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 May 2003.

Documents required for the show

- entry confirmation
- proof of show fee payment
- pedigree (both sides)
- pet passport with official records of vaccinations

General provisions

The show is open to dogs and bitches of the Rhodesian Ridgeback breed registered in FCI-recognized books. Free running of dogs is not allowed in the exhibition grounds. Excluded from the show are bitches in heat, bitches in the second half of pregnancy, lactating bitches and aggressive dogs.

Co-ownership of the dog must be proven by an entry in the dog's pedigree.

Exhibitors are obliged to comply with the provisions of the CMKU Exhibition Rules, these regulations and the instructions of the exhibition committee, to which they undertake by submitting an application. In the event that the exhibition does not take place due to force majeure, part of the fees will be used to cover the costs of the exhibition, the rest will be returned to the exhibitor. Leading puppies for sale at the show is forbidden.

Organizer can change the judges.

A copy of the pedigree (including all sides), a payment proof, a performance certificate copy (for the working class) and a copy of the championship certificate (for the winners and off-competition classes) must accompany the entry form (also in Dogoffice system online). Unless such certificates are enclosed, the entered dog/bitch will be classified to the open class. The copies will not be returned. The Show Committee may reject an application without the proof of fee payment. In case such application is accepted and the dog is entered in the catalogue, the exhibitor is obliged to subsequently pay the exhibition fee even if he or she does not take part in the exhibition.

A dog may only be classified in one class.

Reclassification of dogs after the 3rd deadline is not possible.

Acceptance of a dog to the show will be confirmed by e-mail from Dogoffice online system.

Neither the Show Committee take responsibility for damage caused by a dog or an exhibitor in the venue area including the accommodation area. Such damage is the sole responsibility of the dog owner or exhibitor, respectively.

Neither the Show Committee nor CKRR/KCHRR take responsibility for a dog's loss or death. Free running of dogs is not allowed.

In case of show cancellation due to force majeure, part of the fees will be used to cover the costs of the show, the rest will be returned to the exhibitor. An exhibitor agrees with publication of his/her address in the catalogue.

Complaints

Complaints against judge's decision are inadmissible.

Only formal reasons of breaching the Exhibition Regulations or instructions may be contested. A complaint has to be filed in written form together with a bail of CZK 3000 during the exhibition only. Unless the protest is found justified the bail will be forfeited for the benefit of the show organizer.

Complaints will be decided by a committee of two persons according to the show regulations of CMKU.
